Salt & Access

• LEAVES ... must be placed in special leaf disposal bags which can be purchased at local businesses such as Deaton's Hardware, IGA, Weaver's, etc. The price of the bag is the fee charged for the disposal of the leaves. • DEBRIS - SMALL STUFF ... weeds, bush trimmings, old plants, etc. can be placed in a garbage bag, and put out with the regular trash. • TREE LIMBS, TRUNKS, etc. ... are excluded from village trash, and may not be put out for pickup. It is suggested that you burn it in your fireplace or give it to a friend who has one.

## **Notices for Maintenance Visits**

Members will be notified when maintenance is scheduled. Individuals doing maintenance will ring the doorbell, knock, and wait briefly before entering a member's home on a maintenance visit. A note will be left at the member's home when a maintenance visit has been made. To conserve on the maintenance budget, members will no longer be called prior to a maintenance visit. #### Maintenance Notes

WINDOWS that stick or that do not slide well should be lubricated with a <u>silicon-based</u> lubricant. Warning: <u>oil-based</u> lubricants, such as WD40, will damage the aluminum tracks.

Previously scheduled AIR-CONDITIONER maintenance was canceled because a/c units cannot be checked when the outside air falls below 60° F (as it did recently). Air conditioning preventive maintenance will be rescheduled in the near future.

## Dandelions - Spring Reminder

Please keep the dandelions in your yard cut or removed so that the seeds do not blow into your neighbor's yard.

Firewood - Spring Reminder

Please stack your firewood at least one foot away from your house foundations as well as your fences. Hopefully, this will keep the termites away!

# Parking Guidelines from the Trustees

- Parking on <u>Dayton Street</u> is available anytime for everyone, and is strongly encouraged for party times.
- Parking on PM Drive is limited to the inner part of the traffic circle at the end of PM Drive.
- Parking in the narrow <u>lanes</u> that connect PM Drive to the individual driveways is strongly discouraged.
- Parking in the <u>visitor area</u> at the end of each lane is for short term <u>guests</u> of residents.
- Parking in the <u>driveway</u> of each resident is limited to resident or guest.

- 2) If you are giving your proxy to someone to vote for you, write your name and house number on a piece of paper, and write the name of the person who will be voting your proxy for you. Give the proxy note to the person to bring to the meeting.
