# THE RECIPE CORNER

This dish, which our family has been serving for many years, is a nice accompaniment with turkey and ham for holiday meals.

### **Sweet Potato Bake**

4 cups sweet potato, mashed

2 eggs, beaten

1/4 stick margarine

½ cup sugar

1 teaspoon vanilla

1 stick margarine

1 cup brown sugar

1/2 cup flour

1 cup pecans, chopped

Combine the first five ingredients; mix well and place in a 9"x13" baking dish. Combine the remaining ingredients, saving some of the pecans to sprinkle on top; spread over the sweet potato mixture. Bake 45 minutes, uncovered, in a 350-degree oven.
