Basic Maintenance Schedule for 2013

January 16, 2013 — Salt Levels checked, furnace filters changed out, water filters changed out**

April 17, 2013 — Salt levels checked, furnace filters changed out

July 17, 2013 — Salt levels checked, furnace filters changed out, water filters changed out**

October 16, 2013 — Salt levels checked, furnace filters changed out

** Weather and unforeseen circumstances could play a factor in changing these set times

Extended Time away from Home

The trustees are asking that you inform us if you will be gone from your home for 3 or more weeks. Let a trustee know you will be gone in writing with your contact information and travel dates and who will be checking your unit. In addition we recommend the following checklist:

- O Your unit needs to be checked every 2 weeks for water leaks. You may even want to turn off your water.
- 0 Turn water heater down to the lowest setting to save on your energy bill.
- 0 Turn your air conditioner down in summer. You want to reduce your bills, but you may have to keep the house from getting too hot to protect your plants and electronics.
- 0 Turn your heat down or off in spring or fall. Be sure to leave the house warm enough in the winter. You may want to reduce your bills, but you may need to keep the house from getting too cold to protect your water pipes.
- Unplug electronic items, such as your computer to protect them if there is a storm while you're gone. Remember to unhook your phone line from the modem. Unfortunately, you may have to leave it hooked up if your computer is your answering machine. Make sure your surge protectors are properly installed
